- 4. Bill Singer Gave a slide presentation from a request by the St. Vincent De Paul Society to help a neighbor get a wheelchair ramp so he can get into and out of his home. We currently have a portable ramp that is not being used at Fran DeMarzio's house that we can move over and serve as part of the needed ramp. We will need an additional length to meet with proper coding for ramps at this location. A permit is not needed, but additional sections and components will around \$1,000. Upon further inspection of his house, it was noted that the ceiling in his living room needed replacement due to severe moisture damage. Installation of insulation, vapor barrier, and drywall will run approximately \$500 if we do all the work ourselves. St. Vincent De Paul is helping this man with food, utilities, and social services needed.
- 5. Motion to allot \$1,500 for ramp and ceiling work by Bill Singer, 2nd by Frank Bruzek, passed.
- 6. Dave Porreca is looking for some teens ages 16-20 to do yard work.
- 7. Donations were received from Sam Sorbello and Bryan Driscoll.
